The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners for giving them work and allowing them to work along with the workers whose names are mentioned in the list (Annexure P-1), prior to their juniors who are being allowed to work and were inducted in the department subsequent to the petitioners and other persons.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sunish Bindlish, Advocate and Mr. Gagandeep Singh Malhotra, Advocate accept notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 to 4.

Counsel for the respondents has produced a copy of order dated 31.08.2022 passed by the Divisional Manager, FCI, D.O. Faridabad to submit that the competent authority has already prepared a seniority list of 135 labourers/workers for allotment of work. However, the names of the petitioners do not find mentioned in the said list. Moreover, the said order is not under challenge in the present writ petition.

This fact has not been disputed by counsel for the petitioners.

Resultantly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
