JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus or other writ, order or direction, directing the official respondents to revise the selection/merit list (Annexures P-5 and P-6) finalized by quashing the selection of private respondents keeping in view the merit position of the petitioner by taking into consideration his height to be 6 feet as the official respondents have considered the height to be 5 feet 10 inches, whereas actual height of the petitioner is 6 feet.

This Court, by an order dated 17.03.2022, directed the height of the petitioner to be re-measured by the Central Recruitment Board Punjab Police, however, it appears that the petitioner did not present himself before the Medical Board concerned, as he is already away to Canada since 2020.

This fact was not disclosed by learned counsel for the petitioner on

17.03.2022, when a detailed order was being passed directing re-measurement of his height.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the matter should be adjourned to enable the petitioner herein to come back to India and have his height re-measured, however, this Court is not inclined to agree to the said request made, considering the fact that the petitioner had already left the shores of India in the year 2020 and there is no certainty as to the date of the return of the petitioner herein.

Consequently, the present petition is dismissed.

Miscellaneous application CM-7445-CWP-2017 has rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
