Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0319 dated 24.09.2020 under Sections 323,452,341,427,447,506,148,149 IPC (Section 336 IPC added later on) registered at P.S Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise deed dated 12.07.2021.

Vide order dated 07.10.2021, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate on 16.11.2021 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise and the learned Magistrate was directed to send a report about the genuineness and veracity of the compromise.

A report dated 22.11.2021 of learned SDJM, Sultanpur Lodhi has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Magistrate and got recorded their statements regarding compromise.

Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.0319 dated 24.09.2020 under Sections 323,452,341,427,447,506,148,149 IPC (Section 336 IPC added later on) registered at P.S Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
