Prayer in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondents to redraw the merit list of candidates belonging to BCA category with the averment that petitioner who applied for the post of PGT (Punjabi) in BCA category pursuant to advertisement No. 4/2015 dated 28.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) was wrongly not called for interview to be held on 28.12.2016. There is a further prayer for a direction to carry out scrutiny of documents as the petitioner could not come present on the date when she was summoned as internet services were allegedly not available.

Notice of motion was issued in this writ petition on 11.01.2017.

Short reply on behalf of the respondents stands filed. As per the said reply, petitioner has secured 96 marks and not 98 as claimed by her. The last shortlisted candidate in BCA category is stated to have secured 98 marks out of 160 marks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to deny that in view thereof, no cause of action subsists in favour of the petitioner.

Plea that in case of shortlisted candidates in BCA category making the grade should be considered in general category at the first instance itself holds no merit and is rejected as it is succinctly explained in the reply to the extent that question of consideration of candidate in BCA category for being considered under General category on the basis of merit would arise at the time of final selection and not shortlisting. Thus, the instant petition is clearly rendered infructuous.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
