The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the order dated 19.07.2022 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar vide which non bailable warrants of arrest were issued against the petitioner in case FIR No.231 dated 02.09.2016 under Sections 18 of the NDPS Act 1985 registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

On 26.08.2022 the following order was passed:-

“ The Counsel for the petitioner contends that he was unable to appear on 19.07.2022 due to which non bailable warrants were issued for 29.08.2022. He contends that he is ready and willing to appear before the court to join the proceedings and he has been regularly appearing from the year 2016.

The Counsel for the State on the other hand contends that on 23.08.2022 the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender.

Be that as it may the present petition came to be filed on 22.08.2022 and has been taken up today. The petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender during the pendency of the present petition.

Notice of motion for 20.12.2022.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender himself before the trial court on 29.08.2022 and on his doing so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

The Counsel for the Sate on instuctioins from ASI Gurnam Singh submits that the petitioner has since been acquitted on 16.11.2022.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
