1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 28.03.2022, in CWP-6333-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-6333-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 07.01.2022, in accordance with law, by passing speaking order within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Notice has not yet been issued in this case. However, learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 19.08.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 07.01.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal of the same states that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to

withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 19.08.2022, by

way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
