This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.170 dated 19.08.2021 registered under Sections 306, 506, 120-B IPC at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

Learned State counsel has submitted that as per the investigation carried out, the petitioner has been found innocent and thus, is not required as on date and in case custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required at any subsequent stage, then they would issue 7 days prior notice in writing to the petitioner so as to enable the petitioner to avail his remedy, in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
