In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that she was working on a class IV post on part time basis since 01.01.1990 but despite the fact that several regularization policies were issued by the respondents but the claim of the petitioner was not considered though, the petitioner fulfilled the requirement of the said regularization policies.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had filed representation dated 21.05.2018 (Annexure P-5) with the respondents to grant the petitioner the benefit of regularization policy dated 27.02.2004 and regularize her service w.e.f. the date persons junior to her were regularized and the said representation is still pending consideration

with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case the said representation is decided by the respondents in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the representation of the petitioner dated 21.05.2018 (Annexure P-5) will be decided by the respondents within a period of eight weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
