Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the State to conduct free and fair investigation in FIR No.0242 dated 24.09.2021 registered under Sections 363 and 366 IPC at Police Station Anaj Mandi, District Patiala and further to take action against respondents No.5 and 6 for having enticed his daughter on the pretext of marriage.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that investigations have revealed that the complainant's daughter, after having attained majority, is happily living with respondent No.5 as his wife and therefore the police has prepared a report seeking cancellation of the aforesaid FIR which report shall be filed before the competent Court within two weeks.

In the light of the above statement, no further orders are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is hereby dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file his protest petition to the acceptance of the cancellation report as and when the same is filed before the competent Court.
