Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in a meeting of the General Council of Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad, Panchkula held on 19.12.2017, certain decisions were taken under Item No.7.18 but the same have not been given effect to by the respondents, which act of the respondent-Parishad is causing prejudice to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before respondent No.3-State Project Director, Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad, Panchkula by filing a representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-17), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-17) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-17), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 28.01.2022 (Annexure P-17) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
