The present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside/quashing letter dated 29.08.2017 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No. 1 and order dated 04.07.2017 (Annexure P-3) passed by the office of Superintendent Engineer, Punjab Mandi Board, Amritsar-respondent No. 2. Further, prayer has been made for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents not to deduct any amount from any account of the petitioner, as the petitioner company has already paid all its EPF payments upto date, in accordance with law.

Counsel for the respondents have pointed that the order impugned in the instant writ petition has already been set aside in the statutory appeal and the matter has been remanded to the PF Commissioner, for determination of the liability afresh; by providing opportunity of hearing to the respondent- Mandi Board, as well as, to the petitioner/contractor.

In view of the above, nothing is left to be adjudicated upon by this Court. Hence, the present writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, it is clarified that in case, the PF Commissioner passes an order in favour of the Contractor, requiring return of some money by the respondent-Mandi Board, then the said amount shall be returned to the petitioner/contractor, within a period ten days from the date of order passed by the PF Commissioner.

The parties are directed to appear before the PF Commissioner on 18.04.2022.
