Through this petition, the petitioners seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.490 dated 12.08.2021, registered at Police Station City Panipat, under Section 174-A IPC.

Vide order dated 14.10.2021 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 14.10.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sandeep, submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.10.2021 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
