On 12.12.2022, on behalf of the appellants as well as proforma respondent No.5 statement (separately recorded), was made by learned counsel for the appellants to accept Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the MACT concerned, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect.

Accordingly, Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.50,000/- in favour of appellant No.1-Kailasho Devi; Rs. 50,000/- in favour of Mohinder Singh-appellant No.6; Rs.4,00,000/- in favour of the appellant Nos.2 to 5 in equal share and Rs.2,50,000/- in favour of proforma respondent No.5-Balwinder Devi with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 19.01.2023 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellant as well as proforma respondent No.5 may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
