1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 18.07.2022, in CWP-15162-2022.
2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 18.07.2022, reveals that CWP-15162-2022, was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 herein to consider and decide pending legal notice 23.06.2022, in accordance with law, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the claim of the petitioner was established, to make the payment to the petitioner in terms of his entitlement forthwith.
3. Reply has been filed along with Annexure R/1 and R/2. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of speaking order Annexure R/1 dated 11.08.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 23.06.2022, the petitioner does not press the

instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, with liberty to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 11.08.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.
