The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.151 dated 02.03.2020 under Sections 323, 325, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt. District Ambala, on the basis of compromise, which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and respondent No.2, which has now been settled and they are happily residing at their matrimonial home. He also contends that petitioner and respondent No.2 are serving in the Indian Army.

This Court, vide order dated 06.10.2021 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements and send a report as to whether the compromise has been arrived at without any coercion or undue influence. The report of the Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ambala dated 05.01.2022 has been received, wherein it

is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that compromise which has been effected is genuine, voluntary and without undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and respondent No.2, which has now been settled and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in the case of **Narinder Singh vs. State of Punjab 2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.151 dated 02.03.2020 under Sections 323, 325, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt. District Ambala and all consequential proceedings are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
