The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India a for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing the respondent No. 2 to release the detenue as named in the head note of the petition.

On 22.04.2022, when the matter came up before this Court, counsel for the parties submitted that they wanted to make an endeavour to resolve the dispute and accordingly, the case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.
