JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

By this common order, this Court proposes to dispose of the above noted five writ petitions as same issue is involved.

These five writ petitions have been filed seeking to challenge the impugned order by which the local rank of ASI granted to the petitioners has either being withdrawn or not extended.

Learned State counsel would submit that all these writ petitions stand rendered infructuous as the petitioners have been given the necessary relief. It is submitted that out of the five petitioners, petitioner in CWP-5270-2013 and petitioner in CWP-5338-2013, have even been appointed as permanent Assistant Sub-Inspectors after extending local rank and the other three petitioners, in the rest of the petitions i.e., CWP-5352-2013, CWP-5260-2013 and CWP-5319-2013, have been given the benefit of extension of the local rank of ASI.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel and copy

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of order dated 27.05.2020 passed by Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, having been placed on record in that regard, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petitions and the same are disposed of as having rendered infructuous.

Miscellaneous applications CM-4993-CWP-2013 and CM-4994-CWP-2013 in CWP-5352-2013 stand also disposed of as infructuous.
