Petitioners in this writ petition seek a direction to the respondents to grant selection grade of Rs. 7500-12000/- w.e.f., 01.01.1996 instead of 01.08.2000 to them.

As per averments in the writ petition, petitioners were initially appointed as Masters/Lecturers with the Education Department Haryana and subsequently promoted to the post of Lecturers and thereafter as Principal/BEO/Deputy DEO in the pay scale of Rs.2000-3500. Reliance has been placed on decision dated 01.12.2010 in CWP No. 8082 of 2001, which was upheld by the Division Bench of this Court as well as by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Perusal of the file reveals that none had appeared on behalf of

the petitioners on 18.07.2019 and the following order was passed:-

“Present: None for the petitioners.

Mr. Hitesh Pandhit, Addl.AG., Haryana.

State counsel submits that as per information provided by concerned officer present in court, few of petitioners have been given benefit but claim of few rejected by speaking order and seeks time to place on record details of same.

Adjourned to 05.12.2019.

It is made clear that in case petitioners are aggrieved of speaking order, they are at liberty to challenge same independently instead of pursuing with present writ petition.”

Thereafter, short reply dated 27.09.2019, has been filed along with copy of order dated 05.07.2019, wherein petitioners no.2, 4 and 5, have been found eligible for grant of selection grade w.e.f., 01.01.1996 instead of 01.08.2000. Rest of the petitioners i.e., petitioners no.1, 3, 6, 7, 8 and 9 were not found eligible for the benefit.

In view of order dated 05.07.2019, no useful purpose shall be served by continuation of present proceedings. Needless to say, petitioners no.1, 3, 6, 7, 8 and 9, are at liberty to challenge order dated 05.07.2019, in accordance with law, if so advised.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
