After arguing for considerable period, the petitioner who is appearing in person has consented that she does not wish to press the present writ petition provided her interest is protected. Accordingly, keeping in view the above, following directions are issued :-

i) The Tribunal, which is seized of the matter before which OA No.732 of 2018 is pending for 13.09.2022, shall endeavour to decide the same expeditiously preferably as per its convenience but if possible on day-to-day basis. The Tribunal shall ensure that the order of the Apex Court dated 11.07.2022 in SLP No.10439 of 2022 is duly complied with.

ii) The Chandigarh Administration shall ensure that the order dated 30.12.2019 whereby the petitioner has been redesignated as Professor, Department of Pediatrics w.e.f. 20.10.2019 under the Career Advancement (re-designation in higher cadre) scheme will be issued afresh order without incorporating Clause vi which talks about the pendency of the present writ petition wherein the said designation is subject to final decision. We are of the considered opinion that since the writ petition was raising challenge to the order dated 03.07.2018 (Annexure P-6) of the Tribunal, there was no requirement as such to incorporate the said clause. Needful be done within three weeks from today.

In case, there is non compliance of condition No. (ii) by the Chandigarh Administration, the petitioner is at liberty to approach this Court for necessary direction.

Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed as not pressed but with above observation.

Since the main case is decided, pending applications, if any, stands disposed of.
