Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.63 dated 16.06.2021 for offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 452, 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (later on Section 307 IPC also added vide DDR No.20 dated 03.07.2021) registered at Police Station Uttawar, District Palwal, Haryana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 06.10.2021 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Devi Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 06.10.2021 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 06.10.2021 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
