Reply on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3 has been filed in
the Court today and the same is taken on record.

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is with
regard to the impugned order dated 28.07.2021 (Annexure P-8) by which,
the Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies, Gurugram though gave
directions to the concerned Inspector to conduct the enquiry but revoked
suspension order of the private respondents No. 4 to 6.

Learned State counsel submits that the Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies, Gurugram vide its letter dated 13.08.2021 (Annexure R-1) has already written to the concerned Inspector that appropriate action be taken and the private respondents be not allowed to interfere in the affairs of the society pending enquiry.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No. 4 to 6 submits that they have already received a show cause notice dated 11.02.2022 wherein, on the basis of enquiry report No.349 dated 23.12.2021, the private respondents have been asked to explain their conduct so that appropriate action, if any, be taken.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that they had presented themselves before the authorities on the date fixed and as the Presiding Officer was not present, the same was adjourned.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners will be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the authorities of the Cooperative Societies that the show cause notice dated 11.02.2022 issued to the private respondents is taken to the logical end in time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the private respondents as well as learned counsel for the State raises no objection for the said prayer of the petitioners.

Keeping in view the above, without opining anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to pass appropriate orders on the show cause notice dated 11.02.2022 within a period of six weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It is made clear that appropriate opportunity be given to the person upon whom the show cause notice has been served and speaking order be passed in accordance with law after observing the rules of natural justice. It is also made clear that any party, feeling aggrieved by the said order, will be at liberty to avail appropriate remedy.
