Petitioner, who is 71 years of age has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for seeking direction of respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent No.3, who happens to be his real son, against whom the petitioner had filed a petition under Section 22(2) of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act, 2007 before the District Magistrate, Ambala, for vacating the house, which was allowed by the Tribunal vide order dated 18.06.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide his representations dated 11.01.2002 and 04.08.2022 (Annexures P-2 and P-4 respectively) submitted by him through post. The receipts of the said representations are available on the vernacular of Annexure P-2 at page 20 of the instant petition.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no objection in deciding the representations filed on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representations of the petitioner dated 11.01.2002 and 04.08.2022 (Annexures P-2 and P-4 respectively) and decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law and also take appropriate steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.
