ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

Learned counsel for the State submits that charges were framed against the petitioner vide order dated 04.02.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not challenged the same and as such this petition is not maintainable.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file an appropriate petition against framing of the charges.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has opposed this prayer.

The prayer is innocuous.

As such, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file a fresh petition. It is clarified that that the time period for which the present petition remain pending in this Court shall not be counted for the purpose of limitation.

It is further clarified that filing and withdrawal of the present petition will not come in the way for raising all pleas raised in this petition in fresh petition.

Petition is disposed with the aforesaid observations. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed.
