1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 22.07.2021, in CRWP-6560-2021.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide order dated 22.07.2021, CRWP-6560-2021 was disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram, to consider and decide representations dated 30.03.2021 and 07.06.2021, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

4. Learned counsel contends that pursuant thereto, the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram, decided the aforementioned

challenged the said order by way of CWP-20663-2021 and that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to pursue CWP-20663-2021.

5. Learned DAG, Haryana, states that in view of order dated 23.08.2021 having been passed by the Commissioner of Police Gurugram in compliance of order dated 22.07.2021 in CRWP-6560-2021 and this Court being seized of the matter on a challenge to order dated 23.08.2021, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondent.

6. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties.

7. In view of order dated 23.08.2021 having been passed by the Commissioner of Police Gurugram in terms of order dated 22.07.2021 in CRWP-6560-2021, orders of the High Court have been complied with. Accordingly, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondent. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such with liberty to the petitioner to pursue CWP-20663-2021, in accordance with law.
