Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.127 dated 30.06.2021 under Sections 498-A, 406, 323 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Nathu- Sari Chopta, District Sirsa.

By virtue of the order dated 06.10.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and he has also appeared before the Mediation Centre of this Court as well, thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the parties

appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, however the same remains unsuccessful.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation, however, some of the dowry articles remains to be effected from the petitioner.

The report of the Mediator is also placed on record and shows that despite best efforts, parties could not reach at an amicable settlement.

In these circumstances, this court finds that the matter deserves to be decided on merit.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 06.10.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
