Learned counsel for the petitioner-Federation submits that the petitioners are entitled for pension equivalent to the 50% of the last drawn pay and further for full pension after 28 years of service but, the said benefit has not been granted to the members of the petitioner-Federation, who had retired from service of the respondent-State of Haryana after rendering services on various posts with the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-Federation submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a legal notice dated 28.05.2021 (Annexure P/11) upon them, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.1 to decide the said legal notice in the light of the judgments passed by this Court in **CWP-10731 of 2014** and **LPA No.2242-2016** (Annexures P/9 and P/10 respectively).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 28.05.2021 (Annexure P/11) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner-Federation in their legal notice, respondent No.1 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 28.05.2021 (Annexure P/11) by keeping in mind judgments passed by this Court in **CWP-10731 of 2014** and **LPA No.2242-2016** Annexures P/9 and P/10 respectively by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed off.
