Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has only seven months left before his retirement and therefore, the order of transfer dated 30.06.2022 (Annexure P-3) is liable to be reconsidered by the respondent.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has already moved a representation dated 30.06.2022 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 with regard to the fact that he is left with less than one year of service before his retirement and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 30.06.2022 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 30.06.2022 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of two weeks from the receipt of a copy of this order.
