Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner is covered by the judgment of the Coordinate Bench of this Court in *Narender Pal Singh Arya and another vs. State of Haryana and others, 2017 (1) SCT, 254* and therefore, the petitioner be also extended the same benefit.

Learned State counsel submits that the order passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in *Narender Pal Singh Arya's case (supra)* has already been stayed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP No.47523 of 2018 and therefore, the claim of the petitioner as raised in the present petition is not maintainable.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach again in case, after the

judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the claim of the petitioner subsists.
