The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 CrPC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.121 dated 31.05.2019 under Sections 302 IPC registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently argued that the petitioner is in custody since 31st May, 2019 and that he had no motive to cause injuries on the person of the deceased.

Mr. Karanbir Singh, AAG Punjab apprises the Court that the petitioner is alleged to have caused knife injury blows on the deceased Gurinder Singh. There are as many as 21 injuries on the person of the deceased. He further submits that prosecution has cited 19 witnesses and all such witnesses have been examined by the prosecution and the trial is at its fag end.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid statement and that all

prosecution witnesses have been examined, I do not find any ground to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Petition is accordingly dismissed.
