HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that in principle, the relief being claimed in the present petition, have already been extended by the respondents but actual fixation of their pension has not been done by the respondents in all the cases.

Learned counsel for the respondent-University submits that in case, the consequential benefit of the order granting benefits to the petitioners has not been granted, the same will be granted within a period of next four week.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that in case, the petitioners have any grievance with regard to the fixation of their pension, they be given liberty to approach the respondents for the redressal of the same.

Learned counsel for the respondent-University submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioners raising any grievance, the same will be considered and decided in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, with liberty as prayed for.
