This is claimant's appeal seeking modification of award dated
31.01.2012 passed by the MACT, Palwal.

On request, the instant matter is taken up in National Lok
Adalat accordingly discussed.

As per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned
counsel for the Insurance Company and representatives of the respondent –
Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees
Fifty thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the
Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the
claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the
appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant.

Accordingly, we dispose off this case with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.50,000/- (Rupees
Fifty thousand only) in the name of appellant with the office of the Lok
Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks from today, in

compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent –Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
