This is the second petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.82 dated 30.06.2019, registered for offences under Sections 341, 323, 379, 354 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Majitha Road, Amritsar, Annexure P-2, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise deed, Annexure P-3, arrived at between the parties.

Mr. Prateek Sodhi, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 to 5 and has filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record.
