VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.152 dated 29.12.2020 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take up all the points which have been raised in the present petition, during the course of trial. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a house wife and she has a minor child and thus, prayed that the personal appearance of the petitioner be exempted.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid. The personal appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court is

- i) Petitioner shall be represented through her counsel;
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii) shall not dispute her identity as accused;
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in her absence but in the presence of her counsel;
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;
- vi) any other condition which the trial Court may impose.
