HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is being proceeded against departmentally so as to ascertain as to whether there was any illegality committed by the petitioner while securing the appointment to the post of JBT Teacher. Learned counsel submits that it has already come on record that the thumb impression of the petitioner matches with that of the OMR Sheet and therefore, continuance of the department proceedings against the petitioner by the respondents is totally unwarranted.

Learned counsel submits that the grievance of the petitioner has already been raised by the petitioner by way of representation dated 22.07.2022 (Annexure P-7), which is pending consideration with respondent No.2 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, an appropriate direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 22.07.2022 (Annexure P-7) moved by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 22.07.2022 (Annexure P-7) moved by the petitioner, by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of a copy of this order.
