Status report by way of an affidavit of Kulwant Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Tanda, District Hoshiarpur has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, which is taken on record.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.272 dated 05.12.2021 registered under Sections 307, 365, 323, 447, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 of the Arms Act at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

By virtue of the order dated 26.08.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 26.08.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be

made absolute.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Parvinder Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

Learned Senior counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature.

In view of the above, the order dated 26.08.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
