VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to consider the complaint dated 17.09.2021 in which allegations have been made against respondent no.4 by the present petitioner with respect to extorting bribe from the petitioner's family. It is further submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent no.3 is directed to look into complaint dated 17.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) and after considering the same, to take appropriate action thereupon, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On advance notice, Mr.Dhruv Sihag, AAG, Haryana, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He has submitted that he has no objection in case, complaint dated 17.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) is considered by respondent No.3, in accordance with law.

Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances of the present case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the complaint dated 17.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) and after considering the same, take appropriate action, in accordance with law.

It is, however, clarified that this Court has not gone into the merits of the allegations levelled by the petitioner and it would be open to respondent No.3 to make his independent enquiry/assessment with regard to the allegations made by the present petitioner.

It is, however, clarified that this order shall not debar the State from proceeding against the petitioner, if involved in any case.
