The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide his representations dated 22.07.2002 and 08.08.2022 (Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively) submitted by him through post. The receipts of the said representations are available on the vernaculars of Annexures P-4 and P-5 at pages 29 and 30 of the instant petition.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no objection in deciding the representations filed on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representations of the petitioner dated 22.07.2002 and

08.08.2022 (Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively) and decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law and also take appropriate steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.
