[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 10.03.2022 in CWP No.4793 of 2022.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.4793 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide representations dated 05.09.2021 and 07.01.2022 within eight weeks from the date of receipt of order.

[3] Learned DAG has filed reply dated 14.09.2022 along with order, Annexure R/1 dated 15.06.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy of the same is stated to have already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who states that in view of order, Annexure R/1 dated 15.06.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioners as contained in the representations referred to above, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the contempt petition but pray for grant of liberty to challenge order, Annexure P/1 dated

15.06.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.

[5] Rule discharged.

[6] All pending misc. applications also stand disposed of.
