Aggrieved by non-clubbing of seven complaints under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act (for short 'NIA'), which according to the petitioner were result of single transaction, however separate cheques were issued, the accused has come up before this Court.

A perusal of the petition reveals that legal notices as well as copies of the complaint have not been annexed, even otherwise there are seven separate complaints as such the petitioner has to file seven separate complaints before this Court along with applications for consolidation and joint hearing of those petitions by annexing documents of each complaint in a petition separately, so that the documents cannot be jumbled up.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petitions.
