Status report by way of an affidavit of Dr. Kavita, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, East, Gurugram has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, which is taken on record.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.287 dated 17.07.2022 registered under Sections 313, 376(2) (n) IPC (Sections 354D, 406, 506, 509, 452, 120-B IPC added later on) at Police Station DLF Gurugram, District Gurugram.

By virtue of the order dated 26.08.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 26.08.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Madhu, has

affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 26.08.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
