Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.105 dated 15.09.2021, under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 08.10.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 08.10.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court as well but the matter could not be settled there.

The report of the Mediator has also been received showing that the parties could not reach at any amicable settlement.

Both the learned counsel for the petitioner and respondent No.2 have stated that although the parties could not settle their dispute before the Mediation Centre of this Court but after that they have settled

their dispute independently.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Malkeet Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 08.10.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.

As the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application stands disposed of.
