[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/2 dated 20.07.2022 in CRWP No.6949 of 2022 in case titled as Ram Singh vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/2 reveals that CRWP No.6949 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent that in case the petitioner moved any fresh representation restricting his prayer to the protection of his life and liberty, the same be looked into and if the petitioner found to be genuinely deserving the said protection, to take appropriate action strictly in accordance with law within one week.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to issuance of notice to the respondent to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against him, representation of the petitioner regarding protection of his life and liberty has been rejected vide order dated 31.08.2022 and copy

thereof supplied to him, therefore, in the circumstances, he does not press

the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 31.08.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
