1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 28.04.2021, Annexure P/2 dated 30.06.2021 and Annexure P/4 dated 31.08.2021.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the respondents have informed the petitioner of compliance with orders of Hon'ble the Division Bench, Annexure P/1 dated 28.04.2021, Annexure P/2 dated 30.06.2021 and Annexure P/4 dated 31.08.2021, therefore the petitioner does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
