The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5, as they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners will be satisfied if Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra i.e. respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 18.8.2022 (Annexure P-7), made to him by the petitioners in this regard and take appropriate action on the same.

As per averments made in the petition, both the petitioners are major. Dates of birth of both the petitioners are 12.02.1986 and 12.04.1969, respectively. Copies of Aadhar cards of both the petitioners are appended with the petition as Annexures P-1 and P-2, respectively. This is the second marriage of both the petitioners and their respective spouses have been expired. The copies of the death

certificates of husband of petitioner No.1 and wife of petitioner No.2 Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively. They got married on 23.04.2022 as per Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-5. Photographs of the marriage are Annexure P-6.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Aditi Girdhar, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that respondent Nos.4 and 5 (father and uncle of petitioner No.1 respectively) made statement before the police that they will not interfere in the married life of the petitioners. The copies of their statements are placed on Annexures A-1 and A-2 respectively.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the claim raised by the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra to look into the representation dated 18.08.2022 (Annexure P-7) and decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law.
