Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.69 dated 18.05.2022, registered at Police Station City-II, District Khanna, under Section 22 NDPS Act, 1985.

Affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Police District Khanna, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 31.08.2022, learned counsel for the petitioner restricted his prayer to the grant of interim bail to the petitioner for a period of six months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parents and wife of the petitioner have since expired; that there is no other relative of the petitioner to look after his minor children, aged about 17 years and 13 years.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

A perusal of the affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, District Khanna, would show that the wife of the petitioner has since expired and that two minor children of the petitioner, studying in 10th and 8th standard respectively, are living alone in the house and there is nobody to look after the minor children.

In view of the above, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim regular bail for a period of four weeks from the date of his release, subject to him furnishing the bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

The petitioner would surrender before the concerned Court after the expiry of period of interim bail.
