The petitioners have moved the instant petition to seek the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.244 dated 14.08.2021 registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar Rural, under Sections 148, 149 323, 325, 452 IPC.

At this Stage, Mr. Rai Singh Chauhan, Advocate has joined the proceedings on behalf of the complainant in this case and has forwarded his Power of Attorney to the Court through e-mail and the same has been placed in the file.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh, from the above-said police station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 07.10.2021 as passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined in the investigation and their custodial interrogation

is not required and they are also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

However, all the petitioners shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
