1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.01.2020, in RSA-5511.2016, in case titled as Puran Chand vs. Davinder Kumar.

2. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to notice to the respondent on 16.11.2020, the respondent has handed over vacant possession of the property to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

3. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
