As per the affidavit filed of Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Kurukshetra, the Divisional Commissioner, Ambala Division has reconsidered the matter and granted 4 weeks regular parole to the petitioner vide order dated 27.09.2022. The same has been received on 28.09.2022 and has been forwarded to the concerned District Magistrate, Shamli, U.P. to accept the sureties. The petitioner is, thus, liable to furnish surety bonds before the said District Magistrate.

Counsel has also placed on record the communication dated 20.09.2022 from the Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Jails Department circulated to all concerned including all Divisional Commissioners, Haryana and District Magistrates etc. that parole cases be decided keeping in view the judgment passed in ***CRM-M-34013-2009, Varun @ Golu vs. State of Haryana and others*** and as per the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous and with the assurance that the relevant State authorities shall keep the basic principles in mind while deciding the parole applications so that this Court is not unnecessarily burdened.
