[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 14.01.2019 in CWP No.628 of 2019 in case titled as Nihal Singh vs. State of Haryana and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.628 of 2019 was disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to file a representation for the relief claimed in the writ petition within four weeks and the respondent(s) were directed to pass an appropriate speaking order deciding the same within next three months.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. However, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in the intervening period of time, the respondent has decided the representation filed by the petitioner and rejected the petitioners claim, therefore, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order rejecting the claim made in the representation by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
