AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition was filed for quashing of FIR No. 234, dated 20th May, 2019, under Sections 323, 325 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station SGM Nagar, Faridabad on the basis of compromise.
2. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioners and respondent No.2.
3. Vide order dated 15th January, 2020, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for recording of statements with regard to the compromise.
4. On 11th March, 2022, a request was made for grant of another opportunity by learned counsel for the petitioners. On request of learned counsel for the petitioners another opportunity was granted to the parties to get their statements recorded, subject to payment of cost of Rs.3000/-.
5. Report dated 10th May, 2022 of District and Sessions Judge, Faridabad is received stating that none of the parties appeared for recording of the statements.

6. In view of the above facts the factum of compromise itself is doubtful, the petition is dismissed.
